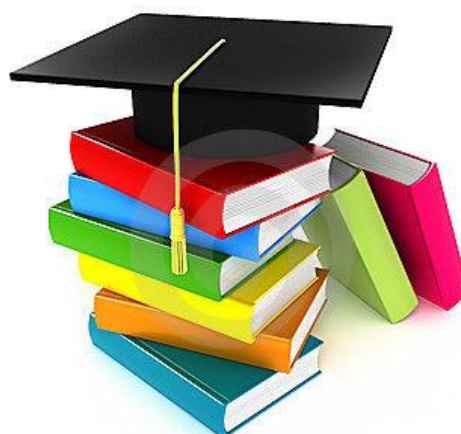

MAY MUSICAL & JUNE CONCERT

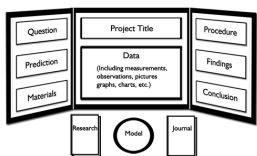

the adventure continues...**

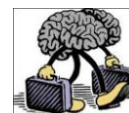
